Re: Mileage Reimbursement Rate for Fiscal Year 2023, First Quarter

The Office of Budget and Management completed the quarterly review of the mileage reimbursement rate as required in the OBM Travel Rule and determined that the rate will increase to \$.58 per mile on July 1, 2022.

If this rate in any way conflicts with the provisions of a current collective bargaining agreement, the terms of the collective bargaining agreement shall prevail.

Please continue to control travel expenses by:

- Using fleet vehicles for official travel whenever possible;
- Conducting meetings, whenever possible and in compliance with ORC Section 121.22, Public meetings – exceptions, using conference calls, teleconferences, webinars, or other technology tools; and
- Following restrictions set by DAS regarding mileage reimbursement pursuant to ORC Section 125.832, Exclusive authority for fleet management.
