- Road
- Bridge/Culvert
- Water Supply
- Wastewater
- Stormwater
- Solid Waste





SCIP

LTIP

• Repair/Replace 90%

• 100%

• New/Expansion 50%

• Only for road or bridge

• Can be combined with loan



- SCIP or RLP loan
- 0% interest
- Term: up to 30-years or useful life of project

Small Government

- \$20 million/year
- Second chance statewide competition
- Applicants with population of 5,000 or less
- Each district submits 7 projects


Policies

• Start construction within 1 year of received agreement

• Completed project within 2 years from starting it

• Extensions approved by Program Rep

Timeline



- Applications, agreements, disbursements will go through this system






Emergency Funds

- \$12 million/year
- Requires immediate action
- Not for delayed maintenance
- Apply through your program rep







Clean Ohio

- Acquisition or easement to protect natural areas in perpetuity
- Riparian corridor protection

Tips for Success

- Know the methodology
- Start application early
- Only submit for projects that are ready to be awarded within a year of release of Agreement
- Be mindful of reasonable engineering costs
