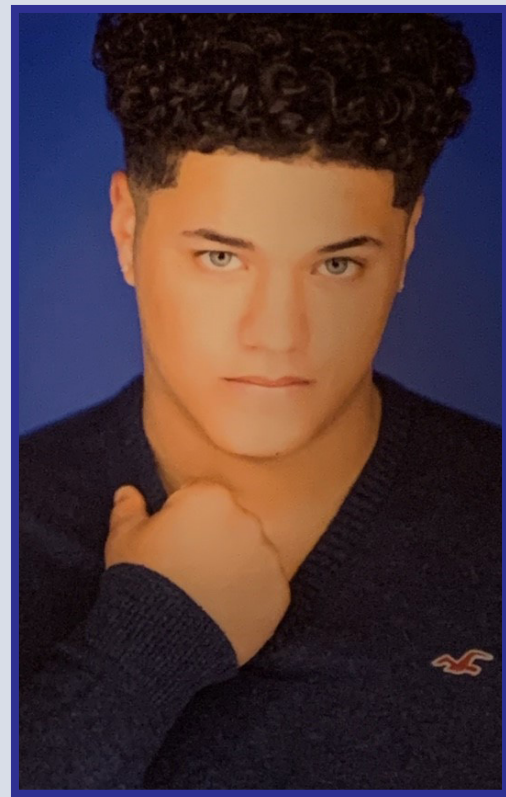
Jaden Jackson
