- 9.2 upgrade caused major issue with Three-Way Match functionality
- Agency issues in adoption

THERESE DYER (OOD)



- Receipts not tied to inventory
- Consumables cannot be tracked
- No value
- Suggested E-Settlement



SUBJECT MATTER EXPERT INTERVIEW

BRIDGET BRUBECK (OBM)



- E-Settlement Process
 - Suppliers enter invoice directly into OAKS
 - State enters in requisition and receipt
- DPS and OOD testing system

CURRENT TECHNOLOGIES

Cost-feasibility study

Optical Character Recognition (OCR) and ERP technology

OBM has tested this technology but not in several years

Increase efficiency and decrease keying errors



SYSTEM INTERFACES

Useful for agencies with inventory

Successfully used by some agencies now

Saves duplication of work



ADDITIONAL TRAINING

Only three agencies using automated process

Many negative perceptions of automated process in OAKS

Formalized training could increase use of existing automated process



E-SETTLEMENT

Still in early stages

Most useful for smaller suppliers

Benefits to supplier

Benefits to agencies

OBM asking all agencies to submit at least one supplier to use E-Settlement
